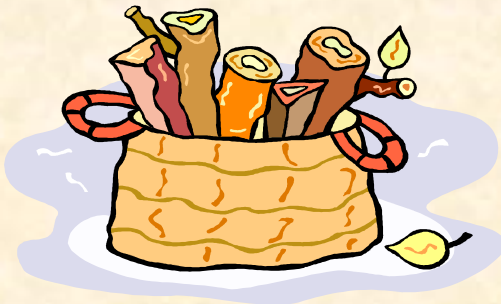


Winter Warmth for Older People Project

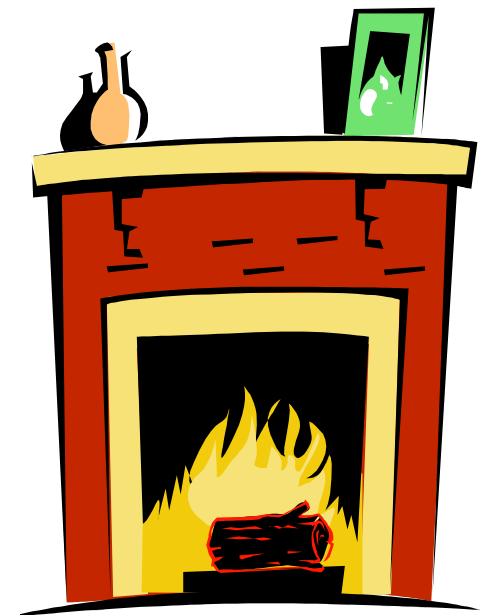

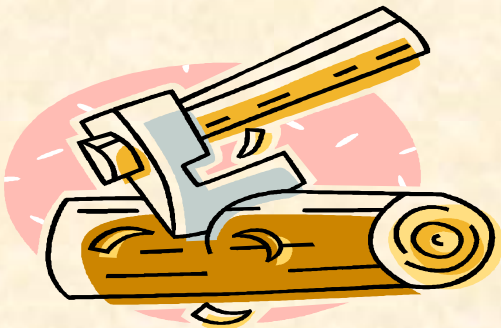

Winter Warmth for Older People Project

We deliver free logs and kindling to people in Dumfries and Galloway over 60yrs of age who are in fuel poverty.

To be eligible for the service households need to be:

- Over 60yrs of age
- Not in paid work
- In receipt of a means tested benefit or have extenuating circumstances



Winter Warmth for Older People Project

Deliveries are made between October and March.

We aim to make as many deliveries as possible.



Deliveries are dependent on the availability of donated wood and the level of demand for the service.
